

RESPONSIBLE PURCHASING POLICY

Asistencias Técnicas de Ingeniería Consultores, S.L., hereinafter ATI Consult, has a global procurement model based on the principles set out in this Responsible Purchasing Policy, to which both the people who work at ATI Consult and society in general will have access. Through this policy we endeavour to:

1. Ensure the **continuous improvement of the procurement process**, based on the principles of corporate responsibility.
2. Stimulate the demand for **socially responsible products, services and/or projects**.
3. Establish appropriate measures to **optimise the impact** of the company's purchasing and procurement decisions on the societies in which it operates.
4. Provide **complete, accurate and transparent information** in its procurement process.
5. Ensure, during the procurement process, compliance with **applicable legal requirements in the areas of human rights, labour and the environment** by all those involved in the process, as well as involve them in the organisation's efforts to prevent corruption.
6. Ensure that the **selection of suppliers** complies with the internal regulations in force at any given time and, in particular, with the **values of our Code of Ethics**, based on respect for legality, commitment to integrity, competition, objectivity, transparency, value creation and confidentiality.
7. Carry out the **appropriate monitoring of the suppliers** with which it relates, in order to prevent the commitments of ATI Consult in terms of social responsibility being affected.
8. **Raise awareness of social responsibility** among staff and other stakeholders involved in the organisation's procurement process.
9. Ensure the **consistency of the Responsible Purchasing Policy with other** existing and/or future policies of ATI Consult.
10. Encourage **collaboration with suppliers** to ensure compliance with this Policy.
